

TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS last updated: 08-02-08

- 1) These are the minimum specifications for the sound reinforcement system required:
 - a) a professional mixing console with a minimum of forty eight channels, each having four-band EQ with sweepable high and low midrange, and a minimum of four auxiliary sends for effects. Preferred consoles: Midas XL4, H3000, XL250, Yamaha PM4000. No Mackie, Allen & Heath or Behringer consoles please.
 - b) a four-way house system of speakers and amplifiers with a minimum stereo output of 3,000 watts, with active crossovers pre-tuned for maximum efficiency and time alignment
 - c) eight working, biamped monitor wedges and one drum fill with a minimum of six monitor mixes: each mix should have a 1/3 OCT 31 Band professional Graphic EQ. See page 4 for information regarding monitor mixes.
 - d) microphone stands in good working order (see channel assignments). WOLF PARADE will provide all microphones and DI boxes.
 - e) Stereo 31-band graphic equalizer for equalization of the entire system, preferably Klark Technic DN360 or better
 - f) house effects as follows: one digital delay (TC Electronic TC2290 is preferred), three digital reverb units (2 Yamaha SPX990 and one TC electronic M3000 are preferred), and one Multi FX Unit
 - g) four channels of gates and six channels of compression. Three dbx 166 units (NOT 166XL) are preferred. No Behringer units please. In addition, one dbx 166 and one BSS 404 will be provided by WOLF PARADE's sound technician.
 - h) a competent, sober sound engineer familiar with the PA system to operate it during sound check and performance, in cooperation with WOLF PARADE'S sound technician; and a competent, sober monitor engineer, unless monitors are run from front of house.
- 2) The PURCHASER will provide professional lighting for the show. The PURCHASER must supply a lighting engineer at no cost to the artist.



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

This stage plot is not to scale.

FOR FESTIVALS ONLY, we require five rolling risers.

- 1. Drum riser: eight feet by eight feet, six inches high (8'x8'x6")
- 2. Stage Right amplifier riser: four feet by eight feet, six inches high (4'x8'x6")
- 3. Stage Left amplifier riser: four feet by eight feet, six inches high (4'x8'x6")
- 4. Keyboard riser: eight feet by eight feet, six inches high (8'x8'x6")
- 5. Electronics riser: eight feet by eight feet, six inches high (8'x8'x6")

Basic Monitor Mixes

WOLF PARADE is not traveling with a monitor engineer.

Monitor Mix 1 (Spencer): guitar 2, guitar 3, kick, snare (top), vocal 1, vocal 3

Monitor Mix 2 (Dante): Vocal 2, bass amp

Monitor Mix 3 (Dan): Lots of vocal 3, plus kick, snare (top), Yamaha amp, a little Yamaha DI,

piano DI, a little piano amp, vocal 1

Monitor Mix 4 (Hadji): This mix is optional, depending on the stage volume. But if requested:

Electronics DI, kick, snare (top), keyboard amps

Monitor Mix 5 (Arlen's wedge): Wedge mix is a fill for the ear mix. Kick (52), snare (top),

plus whatever is requested

Monitor Mix 6 (Arlen's in-ears): Kick (B52), snare (top), rack tom, floor tom, piano DI,

Yamaha amp, a little Yamaha DI, guitar 2, guitar 3, vocal 1, vocal 3

If your venue has side fills, you can put some kick and snare (top) through the side fills and put less in the front wedges. Thank you, monitor engineer.
